The ACRE summary places each student's performance into one of three overall categories: advanced, proficient, or needs improvement. 68.9% of Holy Family 8th graders scored **advanced**, 18% scored **proficient** and 13.1% **needed improvement**.

The school national averages for this assessment are: 16.7% **advanced**, 53.9% **proficient**, 29.4% **needs improvement**.
