The ACRE summary places each student's performance into one of three overall categories: advanced, proficient, or needs improvement. 57.4% of Holy Family 8<sup>th</sup> graders scored advanced, 38.9% scored proficient and 3.7% needed improvement.

The school national averages for this assessment are: 16.7% advanced, 53.9% proficient, 29.4% needs improvement.
