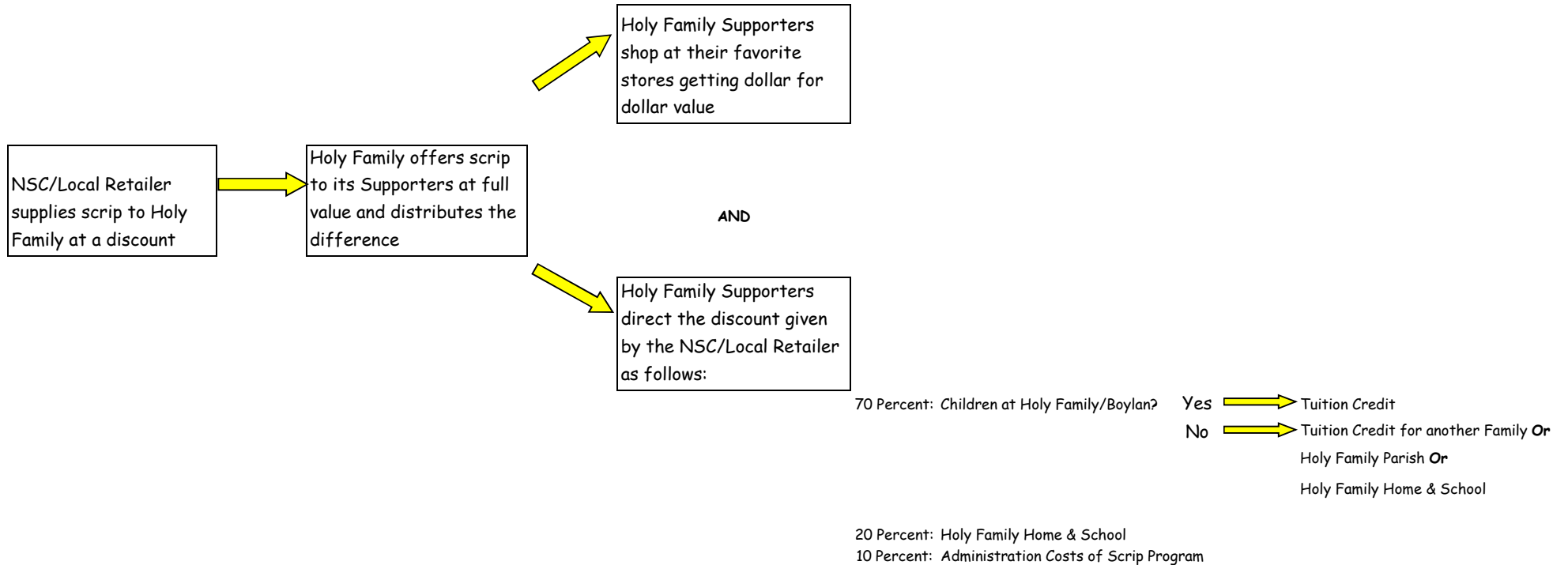


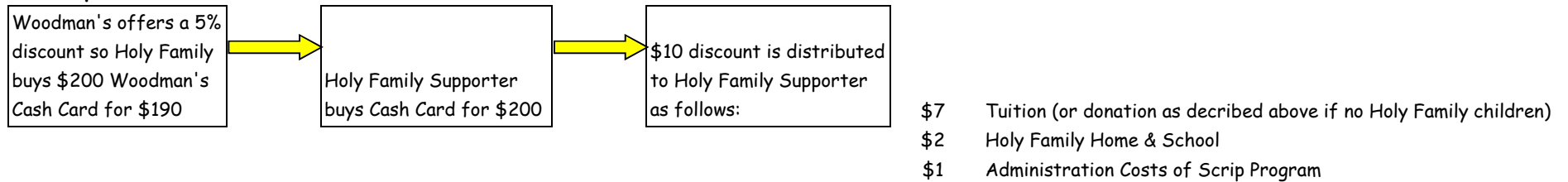
What is Scrip and How Does Scrip Work?



Scrip is a term that means 'substitute money'. When you purchase scrip, you're purchasing negotiable gift certificates and prepaid cards that are used just like cash. You can use scrip to purchase everyday items like groceries, clothing, gasoline and other essentials from your favorite stores. Since scrip is issued in the traditional certificate and prepaid card form, it is a great gift idea for friends, relatives and employees. Holy Family purchases large amounts of Scrip, which allows retailers to offer a substantial discount that ranges from 2% to 25%. That discount is passed back to the Scrip Program. With every purchase, 70 percent of the discount comes back to you in the form of tuition credit, 10 percent towards administrative expenses, and the remaining 20 percent to Holy Family Home & School. Because scrip is like cash and used for daily purchases, it is not tax deductible.
